uman Rights Campaign gives \$100,000 to unami relief

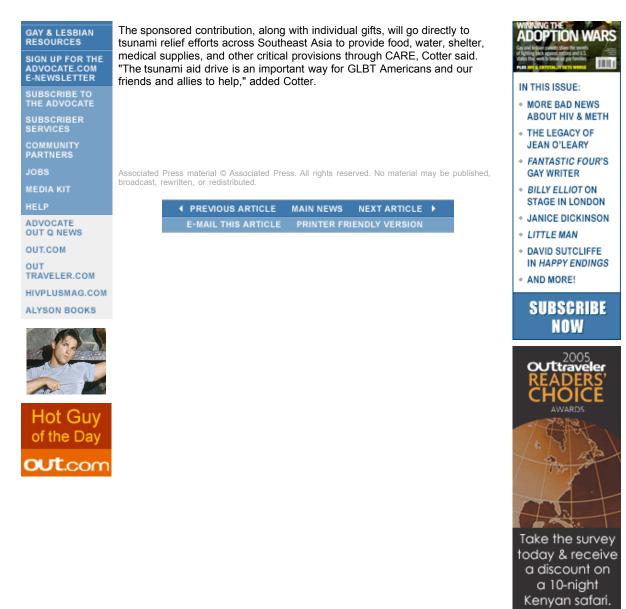
A humanitarian service agency that seeks charitable contributions from the ay community announced on Wednesday that it had received a gift of 100,000 from the Human Rights Campaign Foundation to support tsunami elief efforts in Southeast Asia. "Our work puts our community's highest eliefs and values into action," said Jeffrey Cotter, president of the Rainbow Vorld Fund. "HRC's contribution reaffirms the GLBT community's ommitment to service and charity and will inspire thousands of others to ive what they can to support relief efforts."

"The GLBT community joins with the rest of the world in demonstrating compassion for the tsunami victims in Southeast Asia," said Bruce Bastian, a member of HRC's board of directors and lead sponsor of HRC's gift. "Americans are coming together like never before to help our friends across the globe." Steven Fisher, communications director for HRC, told Advocate.com that no general or program funds were used for the donation. "This money was donated specifically for the tsunami relief in the past week," he said.
